PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Travel and Tourism students are invited to participate in a study abroad program to Vanuatu hosted by Australian Pacific Technical College (APTC) at their campus in Port Vila.

Students can expect a behind the sense experience of the Travel and Tourism industry in Port Vila, participate in workshops with APTC and gain unique insights into the travel and tourism sector from industry guest speakers.

Students will learn about the people of Vanuatu (Ni-Vanuatu), their traditions and customs and be invited to visit special landmarks and the hidden treasures of Vanuatu.

By participating in this program, participants will learn how the travel and tourism industry works in Vanuatu. They can expect to

have a unique experience in Vanuatu, learning what makes it such a special and popular travel destination for international travelers.

PROGRAM INCLUSION

Program cost includes:

- Return flights
- Twin share accommodation (including breakfast)
- Comprehensive travel insurance
- Tuition and material fees for master classes
- Airport transfers
- Contribution to study tour leader costs
- \$250 non-refundable administration fee
- Some sightseeing

Program exclusions:
